- Birds entered in Young Bird Classes MUST be rung with a BLUE 2023 Closed Ring and have been bred in the aviary of the Exhibitor.
- Every care will be taken with birds but no responsibility will be accepted by the Society for loss or mishap to any entry. BCV show rules apply including Judges power to disqualify any bird for non BCV compliance or wrong classification. Ring cards must be produced on request.
- Border District Budgerigar Society's Heat Clause is in place for this show. If on the day of the show the predicted temperature for Sunday 24 March 2024 is higher than 35 degrees on the ABC 7:00pm News Television broadcast on Friday night, 22 March 2024, the show will be postponed or cancelled.
